A By-Law of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, to provide for the classification of assessed property within the Town of Vulcan.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to provide for the classification of assessed property within the Town of Vulcan,

m NOW\ THEREFORE}$ , pursuant to Section 96 of the Municipal Taxation Act, being Chapter M-31, R.S.A. 1980 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

## THAT:

- All assessed property, with the Town of Vulcan, shall be classified as either Residential Property or Vacant Residential Property or Non-Residential Property.
- One rate of tax shall be levied on Vacant Residential Property and Non-Residential Property and a lesser rate of tax shall be levied on Residential Property.
- 3. By-Law No. 947 be and is hereby rescinded.
- This By-Law shall have effect from date of the final passing thereof.
