

TOWN OF VULCAN

BY-LAW NO. 1237

A By-Law of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, to amend By-Law No. 1202, being a by-law to provide for the levying and collecting of charges and rates for sewer services.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan considers it expedient to amend Section 5 of By-Law No. 1202;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT:

1. Section 5 of By-Law No. 1202 be amended to read as follows:

A penalty of 2.5% of the amount of the sewer service charge shall be added to each Utility Statement to provide for a Gross Total payment, the amount so added to be deducted if paid by the 10th day of the month following the date of the statement. If the account remains unpaid after the 10th day of the month following the date of the statement, the aforementioned 2.5% penalty shall form part of the unpaid sewer service charge.

AND FURTHER THAT:

1. This amendment shall become effective February 8, 1999 following the final passing thereof.


READ a first time this 8th day of February, 1999.
