

## BYLAW NO. 1379-09

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW NO. 1202 "BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVYING AND COLLECTING OF CHARGES AND RATES FOR SEWER SERVICES".**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Town of Vulcan wishes to amend Bylaw No. 1202 previously amended by Bylaw No. 1237.

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Town of Vulcan has determined it is in the best interests of the Town to pass such a Bylaw.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. THAT, this Bylaw shall be cited as the "Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 1202".
