

BY-LAW NO. 1226

OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND PORTIONS OF PUBLIC STREETS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1997, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the streets closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Vulcan deems it expedient to provide for a by-law for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to and disposal of same, and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a by-law has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the by-law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, does hereby close to public travel the following described streets, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

That portion of Juno Street (Municipally known as 2nd Street North, Plan 3978HY) including corner cut-offs adjoining the West boundary of Lot 28, Block 40, Plan 9010512 and the North boundary of Lot 25, Block 40, Plan 8510028 which lies Northeast of the production Northwesterly of the most Southwesterly boundary of said Lot 28 excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

By-Law Nos. 440 and 1220 are hereby rescinded.
