STATEMENT:

This policy shall serve as the policy for the use of the Virginia Mitchell Memorial Park.

1. The park shall be open to the public from May 1 to September 30, weather permitting.
2. Revenue generated from the park shall go to park operations and maintenance.
3. Fees shall be:

\$15.00 per night/full hookup sites
(per Motion No. 01.21 – January 22, 2001)

\$ 5.00 per night/tenting area
4. Pre-bookings will not be accepted.
5. Only 8 stalls may be used for stays longer than 14 days.
6. All vehicles must register at the self-registration booth.
7. To utilize a stall:
 - must be a recreational camping unit;
 - one camper vehicle per campsite; one camping unit and tow vehicle per campsite. Tow vehicle must not be over one ton.

8. All pets must be on a leash. Pets must be cleaned up after.
9. Motorbikes and ATV's may not be used in the campground.
10. No business shall be conducted in the park.
11. No campfires are permitted.
12. Waste water or basin water must be disposed of where receptacles or sewer drains are provided. Pouring waste water on open ground or in sump holes dug below trailers is prohibited.
13. Quiet hours are observed from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. No objectional disturbance or unreasonable noise will be allowed at any time.
14. Users of the campground are personally responsible for campsite cleanliness and condition and the conduct of all guests.
15. The area at the north end of the public washroom facility shall be used as storage space and will not be utilized as a concession area until such time as it is developed to the appropriate codes and regulations.
16. Failure to self-register and include proper payment may result in a fine and eviction.
17. The fine for non-compliance may result in a fine of \$25.
