## TOWN OF VULCAN

## BYLAW NO. 1326-05

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BUSINESS LICENSING BYLAW NO. 1121.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan wishes to amend Bylaw No.1121 to modify section 3 and introduce section 3.2.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan has determined it is in the best interests of the Town to pass a bylaw to that effect;

**NOW THEREFOR**E, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1 This Bylaw shall be known as "Bylaw Amending Bylaw No. 1121 – To provide for the licensing and regulating of certain Businesses, Trades, Professions and Occupations."

Section 2 Section 3. of Bylaw No. 1121 is amended by:

- 2.1 After the words "SCHEDULE 'A'" adding " AS MODIFIED FROM TIME TO TIME BY RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL"
- 2.2 By introducing section 3.2 as follows:

"PROFESSIONAL CORPORATIONS EXEMPTED UNDER A PROVINCIAL OR FEDERAL LEGISLATION ARE NOT REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A BUSINESS LICENCE, UNDER THIS BYLAW, IF THE APPLICANT PROVIDES A PROOF OF THE EXEMPTION.

Section 3 This Bylaw shall come into effect from the date of the final reading thereof.

**READ** for a FIRST time this 29<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D., 2005.

**READ** for a SECOND time this 29<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D., 2005.

**READ** for a THIRD time this 29<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D., 2005.
