

BY-LAW NO. 1227

OF THE

TOWN OF VULCAN

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1085, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAINTENANCE, MANAGEMENT, CONTROL AND OPERATION OF THE VULCAN CEMETERY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan considers it expedient to amend Section 9 of By-Law No. 1085;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT:

1. Section 9 of By-Law No. 1085 be amended to read as follows:
 9. No monumental work or structure of any kind, other than headstones, shall be placed on plots or graves.

AND FURTHER THAT:

1. That this amendment shall become effective September 14, 1998 following the final passing thereof.

READ a first time this 14th day of September 1998 A.D.

READ a second time this 14th day of September 1998 A.D.

READ a third time, by unanimous consent of the Councillors present, and finally passed this 14th day of September 1998 A.D.
