

TOWN OF VULCAN

BY-LAW NO. 1126

A By-Law of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, to provide for Mutual Aid in the event of a Peacetime Disaster between the following municipalities:

1. Town of Black Diamond
2. Village of Blackie
3. City of Calgary
4. Village of Cayley
5. M.D. of Foothills No. 31
6. Town of High River
7. Village of Longview
8. Town of Okotoks
9. Town of Strathmore
10. Town of Turner Valley

WHEREAS the Municipalities are municipal corporations located in and to the south of the City of Calgary;

AND WHEREAS an emergency or a disaster could affect the Municipalities to such a degree that local municipal resources would be inadequate to cope with the emergency or disaster;

AND WHEREAS Section 113 (1) of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1980, C. M-26 as amended, authorizes a council of a municipality to pass a by-law authorizing for the performance of any matter or thing considered by all the councils concerned to be a benefit to their respective municipalities and may enter into an agreement as to the joint control and management of anything that concerns their respective municipalities;

AND WHEREAS the Municipalities acknowledge that it is desirable to enter into an Agreement to formalize their rights and obligations relating to the supply of assistance during an emergency or disaster;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Vulcan duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Approval is hereby given for the signing officers of the Town of Vulcan to execute, under corporate seal, an Agreement amongst the Town of Black Diamond, Village of Blackie, City of Calgary, Village of Cayley, M.D. of Foothills No. 31, Town of High River, Village of Longview, Town of Okotoks, Town of Strathmore, Town of Turner Valley, which is attached as Schedule "A" to this By-Law.
2. By-Law 1113 being a By-Law to authorize the execution of a Mutual Aid Agreement amongst certain municipalities is hereby repealed.
3. This By-Law shall take effect as and from third and final reading.

READ a first time this 10th day of June A.D. 1991.

READ a second time this 10th day of June A.D. 1991.

READ a third time, by unanimous consent of the Councillors present, and finally passed this 10th day of June A.D. 1991.
