

BY-LAW NO. 1213

OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1994, a Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting such matters as safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Vulcan wishes to provide to all its citizens access to emergency services via an Enhanced 9-1-1 Service; and

WHEREAS TELUS Communications Limited (TELUS) can provide access to emergency services via its Provincial E9-1-1 Service; and

WHEREAS the Town of Vulcan is desirous of entering into an agreement with TELUS for the provision of Provincial E9-1-1 services which all local subscribers must receive; and

WHEREAS the Town of Vulcan will incur costs to deliver and utilize a centralized Call Answer Service designed to receive E9-1-1 calls made by Local Subscribers in the Town of Vulcan and;

WHEREAS the Town of Vulcan wishes to charge Local Subscribers a user fee for each Exchange Service equipped for outward calling, with the said user fee to be known as a Call Answer Fee, to recover part of the E9-1-1 Call Answer Costs; and

WHEREAS the Town of Vulcan intends to use TELUS as billing and collecting agent for this Call Answer Fee;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Vulcan duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Approval is hereby given for the signing officers of the Town of Vulcan to execute under corporate seal the following agreements with TELUS Communications Inc.:
 - (a) "Agreement to Provision of Provincial E9-1-1 Service"; and
 - (b) "Agreement to Collect Municipal Charges for Provincial E9-1-1 Service".
2. This By-Law shall take effect as and from third and final reading.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND WITH UNANIMOUS CONSENT OF ALL COUNCIL PRESENT A THIRD AND FINAL TIME THIS 26TH DAY OF JANUARY A.D. 1998.
