

BYLAW NO. 1314-04

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE REVISION OF BYLAW NO. 1302 ("CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROAD (ALLEY))

WHEREAS; pursuant to section 63 (1) of the *Municipal Government Act, Statues of Alberta, 1994 Chapter M-26.1* as amended, provides that "A council may by bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of the municipality".

WHEREAS; the Council of the Town of Vulcan, deem necessary to make changes, pursuant to section 63 (2) (i), to bylaw no. 1302, without changing the substance of the bylaw, to bring out more clearly what is considered to be the meaning of a bylaw or to improve the expression of the law by adding more details to the land description

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The Town of Vulcan deem necessary to revise bylaw no 1302 being a bylaw "FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROAD (ALLEY)"
2. By this bylaw, bylaw no. 1302 is hereby revised by adding after:
"A PORTION OF LANE IN BLOCK 4, PLAN 7000 AG"

the following:


"LANE, ALL THAT PORTION LYING TO THE SOUTH WEST OF THE NORTH WESTERLY PRODUCTION OF THE NORTH EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF LOT 11 IN SAID BLOCK, CONTAINING 0.056 HECTARES (0.14 ACRES) MORE OR LESS. EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS"

3. This Bylaw shall become effective following the final passing thereof.


