

TOWN OF VULCAN

BYLAW NO. 1302

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROAD (ALLEY) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described and shown on Schedule A are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the road (alley) closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to, disposing of, leasing of same, and


WHEREAS, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Vulcan in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and creating title to and disposing of the following described road (alley), subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

A portion of lane in Block 4, Plan 7000 AG
