STATEMENT:

The Town of Vulcan requires a policy to define Capital Cost, to better distinguish capital items from operating items.

1. <u>Definition</u>

Capital costs are fixed, one-time expenses incurred on the purchase of land, buildings, construction, and equipment used in the production of goods or in the rendering of services.

- **1.1** Capital costs shall be items that will:
 - (a) Have a useful life of three (3) or more years; and
 - (b) Have a value of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)
- **1.2** Capital costs shall include the construction of a piece of equipment, road, structure, etc. and:
 - (a) Include Town labour, contracted services and materials; and
 - (b) Have a value of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)
- **1.3** Capital costs shall also include renovations where upgrading or additions are constructed increasing the value of the equipment, road, structure, etc. and:
 - (b) Include Town labour, contracted services and materials; and
 - (c) Have a value of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)
- **1.4** All other material costs, labour costs, and/or contracted services will be referred to as operating and/or maintenance costs, or a replacement cost.
