## By-Law #939

A By-Law of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, to regulate the use of locomotive whistles.

 ${\hbox{\underline{WHEREAS}}\atop\hbox{whistle}}$  it is deemed expedient to prohibit the sounding of any engine whistle in accordance with the provision of Section 248 (1) of the Railway Act, at the intersection of the Canadian Pacific Railway, Aldersyde Subidivision, with 2nd St. S. and with Centre St. in the Town of Vulcan.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 248 (1) of the Railway Act, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

## THAT:

1. The sounding of any whistle in respect of the following highway crossings within the limits of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, is hereby prohibited:
