## TOWN OF VULCAN

## BYLAW NO. 1353-07

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING CEMETARY BYLAW NO. 1085/88 AS AMENDED BY BYLAW 1227.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan wishes to amend Bylaw No.1085/88 as amended by Bylaw No. 1227 to modify section 9 and 10 of this bylaw;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan has determined it is in the best interests of the Town to pass a bylaw to that effect;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

 Section 9 of Bylaw 1085/88 amended by Bylaw No. 1227 is again amended to read as follows:

"No monumental work, structure, trees or shrubs of any kind, other than headstones and mini-columbarium for family niches, shall be placed on plots or graves.

- 2. Section 10 of Bylaw 1085/88 is amended to read as follows:
  - 2.1 A headstone shall mean a stone inscribed with such lettering as may be desired by the owner of burial rites an being no more than 24 inches in height and set in a concrete foundation not less than 6 inches in depth and extending no more than 1 inch above ground level and extending a minimum of 8 inches beyond the base of the headstone.
  - 2.2 A Mini-Columbarium shall mean a metal, concrete or granite structure to store no more than 10 urns containing ashes of a deceased person and being no more than 54 inches in height, 40 inches in width and 26 inches in depth and set in appropriate concrete or granite foundation not less than 6 inches in depth and extending no more than 1 inch above ground level and extending a minimum of 8 inches beyond the base of the columbarium.
- This Bylaw shall come into effect from the date of the final reading thereof.
